- Once on **Pigeon Island**, we disembark for a couple of hours to relax on the **beach** and go for swim. Despite its name, Pigeon Island is not an island but a small peninsula jutting out into the sea on the north-western coast of St. Lucia. Its history dates back to 1550, when the French pirate nicknamed Peg Leg made it his base to attack Spanish galleons passing through the Lesser Antilles. Two centuries later, the British under Admiral Rodney fortified the island to monitor the passage of French ships through the Antilles. Nowadays, Pigeon Island is connected to the land by a dam built in 1970 and is a National Park where old military buildings can still be admired.
- We get back on board and return to the ship in the port of Castries on the western coast.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This excursion does not include a guide.
- This tour is not recommended for guests who suffer from sea sickness and those who have mobility problems.
- You must be able to swim.
- Minimum age: 5 years.
- The tour includes lounge and drinks (rum punch, water and non-alcoholic drinks) which can only be served on the catamaran.

TOUR OF SAINT LUCIA AMID HISTORY, CULTURE AND NATURE

In a nutshell

A pleasant excursion to discover the history, culture and nature of Saint Lucia and fully indulge ourselves in the lively welcoming atmosphere typical of this Caribbean island, where we can discover unspoilt places and corners of paradise of rare beauty.

Main stops

- Castries, Morne Fortune
- Caribelle Batik and souvenir shop
- Old Victoria Road (banana orchards and breath-taking views), Ti-Rocher, Babonneau, Paix Bouche, Balata villages
- 'Lushan Country Life': walk among tropical trees, bushes, vines, flowers, butterflies and birds
- Pigeon Island: nature reserve, remains and ruins of old battles, view over Rodney Bay
- Reduit Beach

The programme

- We leave the port behind and delve into the heart of **Castries**, the capital founded by the French in 1650. The city is named after Charles Eugène Gabriel de la Croix, Marquis of Castries, and was destroyed by various fires over the centuries to be completely restored after 1948. Today, it is a typical Caribbean city protected by the bay on one side and by the fortifications, now civil buildings, on the other.
- We move on to **Morne Fortune** along a windy yet picturesque road. The residential areas surrounded by lush vegetation create a typical tropical atmosphere. First stop: view of **Morne Fortune**. From the top of the mount, it is possible to see the port and the city of Castries in all its beauty, and on the clearest and sunniest days, it is possible to see as far as the coast of Martinique. We then continue towards Caribelle Batik. Second stop: **Caribelle Batik**.
- Located not far from Castries, this four-floor Victorian house (haunted by ghosts according to popular tradition) is where West Indian Sea Island cotton is produced. We will have the chance to observe the fascinating batik fabric decoration technique. We will also have time to browse around the **souvenir shop** and buy a few items to take home with us.
- Our excursion continues along the **Old Victoria Road**, surrounded by **banana orchards and breath-taking views** passing through **charming villages** such as **Ti-Rocher, Babonneau, Paix Bouche and Balata**, where we can appreciate the rural part of the island first-hand. Third stop: **'Lushan Country Life'**.
- Our tour also involves a **lovely walk** to discover unspoilt corners of paradise of rare beauty and

immerse ourselves in the typical vegetation among **tropical trees, bushes, vines and flowers** and admire native animals such as **butterflies, insects and numerous birds** that accompany our excursion with their singing. Refreshments await us at the end of our walk. Fourth stop: **Pigeon Island**

- We proceed towards the northern part of the island to reach the **Pigeon Island nature reserve**. Despite its name, Pigeon Island is not an island but a small peninsula (of about 16 acres) jutting out into the sea on the north-western coast of St. Lucia. Once a pirate hideout and a Carib settlement, it is now possible to see the **ruins and remains of ancient battles**. We can enjoy a stroll along paths that take us through the tranquillity of an extremely well-kept environment, without missing the lovely views over **Rodney Bay** (a popular tourist area thanks to its restaurants and night-life, the bay is also the most important international marina in St. Lucia). Fifth stop: **Reduit Beach**.
- Before our excursion ends, we can decide whether to go for a swim in the crystal-clear waters of the Caribbean sea or relax on the amazing **Reduit Beach**, a well-equipped beach in the Rodney Bay hotel area lapped by the calm sea perfect for water sports.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Minimum age: 5 years

A complete tour of the Pigeon Island National Park and its nice beaches to retrace its history and admire the magnificent natural sceneries.

Main stops

- Pigeon Island National Park and two beaches
- Fort Rodney ruins with view over the Atlantic coast Rodney Bay.

The programme

- We set off by coach from the port of Castries and head towards the **Pigeon Island National Park**, a

former island connected to St. Lucia by a dam built in the 1970s. Despite its name, Pigeon Island is not an island but a small peninsula jutting out into the sea on the north-western coast of St. Lucia. Its history dates back to 1550, when the French pirate nicknamed Peg Leg made it his base to attack Spanish galleons passing through the Lesser Antilles. Two centuries later, the British under Admiral Rodney fortified the island to monitor the passage of French ships through the Antilles. Nowadays, Pigeon Island, connected to the land by a dam built in 1970, is a National Park where old military buildings can still be admired.

- On Pigeon Island there are **two small beaches**, where we have some free time to go for a swim or enjoy the sun, sea and sand.
- The most adventurous can take the path that, in 20 minutes, leads to the **ruins of Fort Rodney** (barracks, guard posts and defence batteries), from where we enjoy a spectacular view over **Rodney Bay** (tourist area popular thanks to its restaurants and night-life, the bay is also the most important international marina in St. Lucia).
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This excursion does not include a guide.
- Sun beds and beach umbrellas not included in the price, but available on-site subject to payment.
- The coach transfer from the port to Pigeon Island takes approximately 30 minutes each way.
- Entry to Pigeon Island National Park is in the price of the excursion.

- After, we have a photo stop at **Morne Fortune**, a belvedere perched high up with a most beautiful view of the capital and, on a clear day, of the Island of Martinique. From here we can also see the **Sir Arthur Lewis Community College**, a centre of excellence named after the other Nobel Laureate of the island (Sir Arthur Lewis, winner of the Nobel prize in Economics in 1979).
- We continue with our excursion driving through some villages and typical rural communities that represent the essence of life on the island.
- We then arrive at a point to view **Mount Gimie** which, at an altitude of 959 metres, is the highest point on the island of St. Lucia from where we can see the **Roseau Valley banana plantation**, the biggest plantation on the island. The panoramic views are breathtaking.

In a nutshell

An unusual way to view unspoiled nature in St Lucia and appreciate the rainforest with all its colours from a totally new perspective, gliding along in a cable car to see the lush tropical vegetation teeming with life.

Main stops

- Mountain village at an altitude of 600 m, rainforest crossing by cable car, creeper plants, 'Chatannier', Magnolia and Gommier trees, parrots

The programme

- We leave the port by coach, cut across the capital city, Castries, in the direction of the mountains and head for a **small village nestled in the mountains at an altitude of 600 metres**.
- When we arrive at our destination we are given a security briefing and then we proceed with our **aerial excursion in a cable car through the rainforest**, from where we have a wonderful panoramic view over the vast expanse of the island's lush vegetation which extends from the Atlantic Ocean to the Caribbean Sea.
- Nurtured by warm, gentle rain and rich volcanic soil, St. Lucia's forests have achieved a state of dignified magnificence. Our cable cars glide safely over the tree tops, where a tangled maze of **forest creepers** wrap themselves round the old trees all the way to the very top. Among the many plants we can see, there are **Giant 'Chatannier' trees** (Chestnut trees with massive trunks of particularly hard wood and a highly developed root system), **Magnolias** and **Gommier trees**, that

are all over the terrain providing food and shelter for St. Lucia's **endemic and endangered parrot**.

In a nutshell

Discover the natural beauty of St. Lucia as you wind your way through banana and coconut plantations, lush tropical vegetation and above all enjoy a mud bath at the island's famous sulphur springs where a true 'volcanic treatment' awaits us.

Main stops

- Two fishing villages, rainforest and banana and coconut plantations
- Twin peaks of the Pitons
- Town of Soufrière: sulphur springs, sulphur fumaroles, boiling water pools, crater's lunar landscape, mud bath pools
- Marigot Bay

The programme

- Our panoramic drive takes us through two traditional **fishing villages** and skirts around the **lush rain forest**, where the landscape is dominated by **coconut and banana plantations**.
- As we descend towards the **town of Soufrière**, the impressive **twin peaks of the Pitons** come into view. The two cone shaped volcanic plugs (with an altitude of 750 and 797 metres respectively) have become a symbol of the island and have been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Next we visit the **sulphur springs**. This is the only volcano in the Caribbean that is accessible by car

thanks to a road that goes around the crater. The volcano has been dormant since the early 18th century. Here, you can see close up the **sulphur fumaroles and the bubbling pools of water** and the lunar landscape of this volcanic crater.

- Thanks to the sulphur seeping through the rocks, this place is famous for its mineral mud baths that have renowned therapeutic properties. The Empress Josephine used to bathe regularly in the spectacular Soufriere caldera. We will also have the opportunity to have a truly 'volcanic treatment' and experiment with the wonderful **mud pools** at the bottom of the springs where, thanks to the air that is full of sulphur fumes, we can benefit from all of their therapeutic properties against arthritis, asthma and skin disease. An expert guide explains how to make the most of this wonderful natural resource.
- On our return journey to the port, we have a brief stop at the famous **Marigot Bay** (described by the English writer James Michener as the most beautiful bay in the Caribbean), an exceptionally beautiful natural yacht harbour and haven for artists and writers. Here we have a magnificent panoramic view of the natural bay that has been used as a film-set in many famous films.
- This excursion will be led in English.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Minimum age: 5 years.
- The itinerary of this excursion crosses winding and uneven roads, guests must therefore be able to walk on this type of road and climb approximately 30 steps to the sulphurous springs and mud baths.
- Bathing in the natural tubs is optional and is not recommended for guests allergic to sulphur.
- We recommend wearing light clothing and comfortable shoes.
- We recommend wearing dark clothing when entering the mud baths, as they may stain clothing.
- You need to be physically fit to take part in this excursion.

- First opened to the public in 1981, Harrison's Cave can only be visited on **electric trams** through tunnels and caverns to see how the rocks have been slowly eroded and sculpted over thousands of years.
- The light which filters through the limestone walls renders this amazing **underground world** even more magical.
- We are surrounded by thousands of **stalagmites and stalactites**, some of which have joined to form columns, **natural waterfalls and crystal clear lakes** : a unique natural spectacle.

- When we reach our destination, we will get off the train and start exploring this wonderful place, surrounded by a **lake inhabited by migratory birds**, thriving **mahogany forests, towering palm trees, sugar cane plantations** and stones from an **abandoned limestone quarry**, which is believed to have been the source of the original stone used to build the residence.
- Before we leave, we will have the chance to see and take photos of the locomotive changing direction as it is linked to the opposite end of the carriages for the return journey.
- At the train's double whistle, we will get back into the carriage and descend back down the hill, admiring **breathtaking views of the north coast of the island and the sleepy rural villages** in the area.
- When we reach **the station**, we will have **free time to visit the souvenir shop and buy a few things**, including rum and sugar-based products produced and only sold here.
- After shopping, we will **return to the port by coach**, stopping for **photos at the Morgan Lewis Mill**, the largest remaining windmill in Barbados, which dominates the **stunning views of the Atlantic coast**.

- Who would have ever thought that a small laboratory producing eccentric works in clay would become one of the most recognizable Barbadian and Caribbean art studios.
- Immediately following **another burst of colors** awaits you, that of the **Flower Forest**, found in the **heart of the island**. First it was a sugar plantation, but today, **thanks to your contribution** and to that of gardening enthusiasts, the **rainforest** is back: dive among the **palm trees, exotic plants and flowers** blooming all year. **Heliconia wagneriana? flamboyant? orchids?** Let yourself be guided by the colors and the fragrances and choose your favorite. Once the stroll is over, not only will you be able to recognize tropical trees and plants, but you will take with you a unique **sense of peace**.

HELICOPTER TOUR: THE ISLAND OF MONTSERRAT AND ITS VOLCANO

In a nutshell

This excursion offers the unique, rare and exclusive opportunity to visit the Island of Montserrat and observe close up and in total safety, the active Soufrière Hills volcano.

- Tragically, the island was devastated by the eruption of the **Soufrière Hills** Volcano. Having remained dormant for a long time, in 1995 the 914-metre high volcano erupted, forcing two thirds of the population to abandon the southern part of the island and consequently even the capital, Plymouth. For this reason, there is an 'Exclusion Zone' that covers the whole south-eastern half of the island extending to about two miles from the coast.
- In the 80 sq. km of the 'Exclusion Zone' all means of transport are prohibited and nobody is allowed to live there. For this reason, the only way to observe close up the **puffs of ash, smoke and steam** emitted by the volcano is by helicopter.
- During the flight, with a running commentary from the pilot, we also see the **remains of the villages**

that were devastated by the eruption and the **ruins of Plymouth**, now uninhabited and partly buried under 12 metres of ash. This is undoubtedly a rare and very moving experience. Finding yourself in front of such dramatic evidence of the force of Nature cannot fail to amaze you and make you reflect.

- Our first stop is the famous **Alcázar**, where Don Diego Colón, first governor of Hispaniola island and son of Christopher Columbus, used to live. It was built between 1510 and 1512 by over 1500 Tiano indios without the use of a single nail, but only rudimentary tools such as saws, scalpels and hammers.

- We stroll through the amazing **colonial quarter**, the first still-existing settlement created by Christopher Columbus upon arriving in the New World, and admire ancient buildings such as the **National Pantheon**, resting place of many Dominican heroes.
- If we want to buy a few souvenirs, the characteristic **colonial market** is the perfect place to choose traditional handicrafts, jewellery, cigars and rum.
- We then head to the **Cathedral of Santa María La Menor**, the first of the Americas and a source of pride among the Dominican population.
- We leave the colonial quarter and make our way to a **buffet lunch**.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This tour is not recommended for guests who suffer from sea sickness and those who have mobility problems.
- The coach journey from the International Tourist Dock to La Romana at Santo Domingo takes around 2 hours each way.
- This excursion involves a lot of walking, it is therefore recommended to wear comfortable shoes.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- The excursion returns to the port and is reserved for both guests in transit and disembarking. Check on board if the tour is compatible with your flight.

Number of participants

Duration

Guests with limited mobility
