KIE20T - PANORAMIC KIEL AND SURROUNDINGS

SCENIC ROUTE



This panoramic tour will give you an excellent overview of Kiel, your port of call, as well as the surrounding countryside. Thanks to its advantageous coastal location on the Baltic Sea, the beautiful city of Kiel the capital of the state of Schleswig-Holstein is characterised by a rich maritime and naval tradition that it still maintains to this day. Kiel enjoys an international reputation as the venue of several important sailing events, including the annual Kiel Week the world's biggest sailing competition. In fact, the first-class conditions at sea and meticulous organisation on land have lent Kiel the title of "the world's unofficial sailing capital", especially since the city hosted the Olympic sailing competitions in 1936 and 1972. One of these was held in the Kiel suburb of Schilksee, which is naturally on the itinerary. The many little sailing boats and the unique architecture of Schilksee are a living testament to the colourful event. The tour of the city will also take you to see the famous early 20th-century town hall, the majestic Kiel Fjord, an inlet of the Baltic Sea, and the impressive Kiel Canal, which both connects the North and Baltic Seas and is the world's busiest artificial waterway. Your return to the pier and your ship marks the end of this scenic excursion. Please note: this excursion is only guests who do not embark/disembark in Kiel. Wheelchair users must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Wheelchair users wishing to take part in this are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made. KIEBK1 - KIEL COAST AND COUNTRY BIKE TOUR







What better way to get to know the attractive and very varied scenery around the historic port of Kiel than by bicycle? From the port, head into Kiel city centre, home to Germany's longest shopping street and clusters of restaurants and bars. As you leave the city, the landscape starts to turn green, and the journey from Neumühlen-Dietrichsdorf and Mönkeberg takes you past green forests and grassy verges. But it doesn't stay green for long. When you arrive in Heikendorfer Bay, you'll be met by a coastal scene. You'll pedal past waterfront villas with reed roofs, sail boats anchored in dinky marinas, and sandy beaches backed by woodland. The last leg of your outward-bound cycle will take you to Laboe, where the beach has an unusual feature: a huge German submarine on the sand! It's part of the town's naval memorial and museum. During your break in Laboe, you can visit the submarine, watch the kite-surfers from the beach or relax with a drink in one of the seaside cafés, before cycling back to the ship. Please note: Guests will cycle for a total of 35 km. Children are allowed to take part in this tour provided their height is 155 cm. A declaration of agreement must be signed by an adult with parental authority for children before authorisation can be given for such guests to take part.

KIEBK2 - DISCOVER KIEL AND ITS ENVIRONS BY E-





Explore the attractive and varied scenery around the historic port of Kiel on a pedelec, an electrically powered bicycle with a small motor to assist you as you pedal. From the harbour, you'll start by cycling directly north. Pedalling out of the city, enjoy the green scenery all around you, passing grassy meadows on the route from Düsterbrook and Strande. The landscape then changes as you hit the coast and find yourself cycling among waterfront communities of red-roofed villas, marinas filled with sailing boats, and forests leading down to sandy beaches. Arriving at Bülk Lighthouse, you can watch the ships entering the mouth of the Bay of Kiel. Enjoy a coffee while you admire the splendid views, before beginning the ride back to the port. Please note: Guests will cycle for a total of 42 km. Children are allowed to take part in this tour provided their height is 155 cm. A declaration of agreement must be signed by an adult with parental authority for children before authorisation can be given for such guests to take part.
