OVERVIEW

See how the 2018 eruption of the Kilauea volcano dramatically changed the landscape of the Big Island and pause along the way to sample iconic Hawaiian products. Rainbow Falls will serve as an introduction to the island's natural beauty, which is even more spectacular at Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, Hawaii's only UNESCO World Heritage site. There, you will enjoy a close-up view of how the volcanic eruption expanded the Halemaumau pit crater with a billion cubic yards of lava. As you walk across the now hardened lava field, you will notice new greenery that will eventually become rainforest. The island's fertile volcanic soil is ideal for growing products such as macadamia nuts. You will be offered tastings of them – perhaps honey-roasted or dipped in chocolate – at the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Farm. A Hawaiian-style lunch follows at Volcano Gardens Arts. Confections and coffee are available at Big Island Candies.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Behold Rainbow Falls, which is named for the rainbows that often form in its mist.
- See how a 2018 volcanic eruption changed the terrain in Hawaii Volcanoes National Park.
- Walk across a hardened lava field from the eruption, where plants are now growing.
- Enjoy a lunch of traditional Hawaiian cuisine and sample iconic Hawaiian products.

HELPFUL HINTS

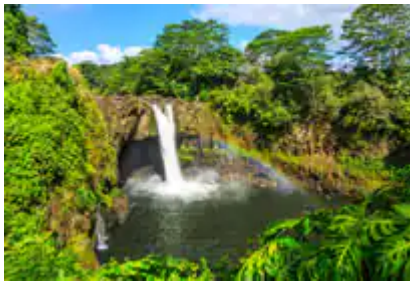
- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

Need to Know:

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Lunch includes freshly made wraps (including vegetarian), island fresh fruit, homemade "purple" potato salad, macadamia nuts, assorted snacks, aloha fruit drinks and bottled water. Natural sulfur gases may affect those with respiratory problems. Tour itinerary may change due to weather or volcanic activity.

Crater Hike & Hilo Waterfalls

The setting is so extraordinary that UNESCO deemed the park a World Biosphere site and a World Heritage site. To reach the crater, you will hike three miles roundtrip. The sights along the way will make it well worth the effort, as the volcano has been steadily erupting since 1983 and the surrounding countryside is dramatic. Afterward, you will pause for photos at magnificent Rainbow Falls, which is named for the rainbows that often form in the surrounding mist. Another photo opportunity awaits you at Liliuokalani Gardens, which pays tribute to the Japanese immigrants that worked in the sugarcane fields more than a century ago. Enjoy a local shopping stop where you can sample Hawaiian macadamia nuts before returning to the ship.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Hike through the dramatic countryside to a volcanic crater that continues to erupt.
- Enjoy photo opportunities at Rainbow Falls and Liliuokalani Gardens.
- Enjoy a local shopping stop and sample Hawaii macadamia nuts.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

Need to Know:

Note: Participants must be fully mobile and capable of walking unaided for more than three miles on moderately rough surfaces, hills, and uneven terrain. They must also be able to climb in and out of a mini bus unaided. Scooters, wheelchairs and walkers can't be accommodated. Box lunch included.

Rainforest Zipline & Waterfall Adventure

Imagine yourself flying through a tropical rainforest canopy over splashing streams and waterfalls on a seven-stage zipline course with a view of the crystal blue Pacific Ocean in the distance.

You'll be surrounded by natural beauty as you hike from one line to the next. A portion of the hike is on a suspension bridge that cuts through the jungle with several small waterfalls below. This course was created to provide a safe and fun environment for the entire family. All lines are ground-to-ground making it easier for all to participate.

After your zip line adventure, enjoy a relaxing stroll through the World Botanical Gardens and the soothing view of a cascading waterfall.

Need to Know:

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh between 70 and 275 lbs. and must be comfortable with heights. If you have back problems, existing heart conditions or are pregnant, this tour is not for you. Must wear closed-toe shoes, pants or long shorts, long hair tied back, with no dangling jewelry. If a child is 4 years old or older and at least 35 lbs., they can ride tandem with a guide for this adventure. We need a 24 hour notice to ensure there are enough guides to accommodate the child that weights less than 35 lbs.

Taste a variety of locally grown foods for a better understanding of Hawaiian cuisine and how dishes made with the produce pair perfectly with craft beers. While touring the fields and orchards of O.K. Farms, you will sample freshly picked herbs and spices such as lemongrass and vanilla. You may also bite into a ripe lilikoi, one of the farm's many tropical fruits that make their way into the zesty libations that nearby Ola Brew creates. Before reaching the brewery, you will pause for photos of Kaimukanaka Falls and Rainbow Falls, two beautiful cascades in the idyllic countryside. Prepare to be equally impressed with the offerings at Ola Brew, which infuses their beers with unusual local ingredients. You will be served a flight of beers that may include a mango-flavored IPA, a lager with banana notes, and a pineapple hard cider. They will be paired with American Asian fusion-style dishes.

- Sample locally grown fruits, herbs and spices while touring O.K. Farms.
- Taste beers at Ola Brew that are infused with unexpected ingredients from the farm.
- Enjoy inspired pairings of the beers with American Asian fusion-style cuisine.

Your exciting day begins with a scenic narrated drive along the beautiful Hamakua coastline from the cruise ship pier to the rain forest at Botanical World Adventures.

Take an incredible journey by bike through an area of the Hamakua Coast once dominated by Hawai'i's sugar industry. This adventurous tour makes its way through a segment of the Old Mamalahoa Highway where you are surrounded by green rolling pastures and lush botanical scenery. This once well traveled road takes us back in time as we make our way through old plantation villages, cross over bridges from the early 1900's and become mesmerized by the abundance of greenery. View beautiful streams and waterfalls originating from the slopes of Mauna Kea as you cross over each bridge.

This ride engages all of our senses with the smells and sounds of the rainforest, the sights of the brightly colored tropical flowers, and the tastes of paradise. Within the botanical gardens you are surrounded with an entourage of foliage from all over the world, as there are fruits in the trees above you, orchids blossoming beside you, and a carpet of grass below you. Before you know it, you are on a treasure hunt to find all the seasonal jewels and gems this amazing botanical garden has to offer. The guides will then transport you by van to their private waterfall on the property for one last amazing photo opportunity!

The experience continues as you journey back to the pier with a stop at Low Store, a family owned treasure since 1925 where you can purchase tropical smoothies and Hawaiian shaved ice. Then continue on the incredible scenic route of Onomea Bay to make a final stop at Big Island Candies, famous for their handmade macadamia nut shortbread cookies dipped in chocolate!

Need to Know:

Note: Wear comfortable clothing in layers, sunscreen, and closed toe shoes (required). Participants are also required to wear the provided helmets while cycling. Participants must be at least 12 years old, 54" tall and comfortable riding a bike. An adult must accompany children under 18 years of age. Volcanoes National Park

Spectacular volcanoes, craters and steam vents are waiting to be explored at Hawaii Volcanoes National Park that has recently reopened after a period of tumultuous volcanic activity. The landscape of Volcanoes Park has dramatically changed as the floor of the Kilauea crater sunk over 1,500 feet and the overall caldera quadrupled in size and widened by over a square mile.

Today, the explosive eruptions, earthquakes and ash clouds have been replaced by remarkable changes in the summit area.

The highlights of this exciting tour include approximately half hour visits at each of the following destinations in Hawaii Volcanoes National Park while riding to each stop in comfort on a deluxe motor coach. Walk through the Kilauea Visitors Center to receive information on the Park's current conditions, view educational exhibits and interact with park rangers. Then you'll be engulfed in rising steam as ground water seeps down to the hot volcanic rocks at the Steam Vents. The area between the edge of Kilauea's caldera and the outer cliffs are treeless because the extreme heat destroys their roots; only shallow-rooted grasses and other hearty plants survive here. Unforgettable views for miles are offered from the Jagger Museum Overlook. Kilauea's massive size and scale is realized from this vantage point and Halemau'uma'u Crater and Mauna Loa are seen in the distance. On your return to the pier, stop and experience Hawaii's Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Visitor Center. Award winning Mauna Loa has over 30 year history of perfecting one of the most delicious Macadamia Nut in the world. The Volcanoes National Park Tour is not to be missed and includes round-trip transportation from the pier by deluxe motorcoach.

Secrets of Puna

Exploring Hawaii Island's explosive side is what this tour is all about. Walk Kilauea's most recent lava flows along the East Rift Zone, including the historic flows of 2018. Start with a drive through quaint Hilo town where you'll drive along the historic waterfront past Liliuokalani Japanese Gardens before heading out to Kilauea. Your National Park Service certified guide will discuss the volcanology, geology, and history of Hawaii, as well as providing in-depth narration on the various lava flows and flora and fauna that you'll be passing by. First stop is MacKenzie State Recreation Area closed by the marching 40 foot tall wall of crumbly a'a lava as it continued through the Park to the sea. Take a walk along the altered coastline and cliffs overlooking the new black sand beach. Isaac Hale Beach Park is next. Lava flows encircled this popular Park miraculously sparing the infrastructure while completely destroying everything around it. Be sure to check out the boat launch ramp, now sitting in a pond cut off from the ocean by a natural berm of lava.

Stop by Star of the Sea Painted Church. Moved by the community twice to save it from advancing lava flows in 1990, this decommissioned church is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. A deli style lunch is included. The final stop includes snorkeling, swimming and shopping. Grab a free snorkel set or just jump in the water and explore the unique lava rock coastline of Hilo Bay. Kayaks and paddle boards are available to rent. Stock up on fresh roasted Kona coffee, Hawaiian mac nuts, and other local products and crafts before heading back to the port.

Note: There are opportunities to purchase local products and souvenirs along the way. Note: Wear comfortable closed-toe shoes, and bring a swimsuit and towel. Tour capacity is limited, molten lava will not be seen, and order of itinerary may change. Participants must be at least 4 years of age.

Secrets of Hamakua

Hilo, Hawaii

Explore the famed Hamakua Coast, home to magnificent country reminiscent of “old Hawaii” on this small-group adventure. Sparsely populated Hamakua is studded with breathtaking waterfalls, stunning valleys, and eccentric towns. Traveling north, first stop at Tex Drive-In, famous for made-to-order malasadas. These fried Portuguese sweet treats were originally brought to Hawaii by immigrants who worked in the cattle industry and have been a local favorite ever since. Watch the treats being made through the window and have the option to purchase a fresh one with a cup of coffee. The Valley of the Kings, Waipio Valley is a place of impossibly steep cliffs carved by plunging waterfalls cascading more than a thousand feet to the valley floor below. Waipio Valley is still home to taro farmers as it has been for a thousand years. Look closely from the overlook and glimpses of the wild horses that roam the valley floor might be possible. Turning off the highway we descend into Laupahoehoe Point. Laupahoehoe village was located here until the destruction left behind the 1946 tsunami forced the town to move to higher ground.

. Look for the monument erected in the names of those who lost their lives here. Next stop at Akaka Falls State Park, the site of the largest easily accessible waterfall on the island. You'll traverse a paved walking path right through the center of a lush rainforest to Akaka Falls, a stunning 442 foot waterfall that plunges down a sheer cliff and into the water below. Continue your adventure with stops at two icons of Hilo, Rainbow Falls and the King Kamehameha statue. Rainbow falls is an iconic waterfall right off a postcard featuring an 80 foot tall twin waterfall system. Look for the rainbow effect that gives the waterfall its name! Leaving the Hamakua coast behind, you travel to historic Hilo Bay to enjoy a deli style lunch. Snorkel, swim or rent a kayak to explore Hilo Bay. Complete the day with a shopping stop with Hawaiian mac nut samples, Hawaii Island crafts, local products, Kona coffee and more.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. Tour capacity is limited and the order of the itinerary may change. Wear comfortable closed-toe shoes and bring a swimsuit and towel. There are opportunities to purchase local products and souvenirs along the way. Guests who

Enjoy an enlightening tour of America's southernmost winery and sample a variety of its premium wines. A spectacularly scenic drive inland will bring you to the aptly named Volcano Winery, whose vineyards blanket an elevated expanse of volcanically formed terrain. Grape varieties such as Symphony, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Cayuga White flourish there. While touring the family-owned winery, you will discover how these unique wines have been produced over the past several decades. Many of them are infused with local fruits such as yellow guava and jaboticaba berries that lend the wines their original flavors. Others are infused with Hawaiian-grown tea and honey from bees that pollinate the blossoms of the island's famed macadamia nut trees. The exact wines for your tasting will be chosen upon your arrival to ensure that they are at their peak. They many include Volcano Red, a signature red blend with black cherry and cranberry notes.

- Tour the family-owned Volcano Winery, the southernmost winery in America.
- Sample a selection of premium wines, many of them infused with local fruit flavors.
- Enjoy a picturesque drive inland through a lush volcanically formed landscape.

Waterfalls & Tropical Farm

Browse the fields and orchards of O.K. Farms and enjoy a sampling of its produce before heading deeper into the tropical environs to view two breathtaking waterfalls. Although remarkably close to Hilo, the family-owned farm feels as if it's light-years away. Fruit and nut trees flourish, coffee plants blanket the hills and the aroma of spices wafts through the air. As you will discover, sweet lychees and longans are by far the most prevalent fruits grown there. You will likely sample them along with rambutans and hearts of palm. You will also learn a trick for cracking the rock-hard shells of macadamia nuts without damaging the meat inside. The Wailuku River winds through the 1,000-acre farm, creating Kaimukanaka Falls, which will be quite the sight to behold. You will view equally magnificent Rainbow Falls from a private vantage point that highlights the iridescent rainbows that typically form in the mist.

- Tour a family-owned farm that grows tropical fruits and nuts within its 1,000 acres.
- Sample iconic Hawaiian fruits such as lychees, longans and rambutans.
- View two absolutely gorgeous cascades: Kaimukanaka Falls and Rainbow Falls.

Wine & Hors D'Oeuvres at Volcano House

Savor wine and hors d'oeuvres at the Volcano House, the only hotel in Volcanoes National Park, Hawaii's only UNESCO World Heritage site. As an introduction to the wonders of the surrounding volcanic landscape, you will accompany a volcanologist on a leisurely walk along the summit rim of Kilauea, one of the world's most active and easily accessible volcanoes. It will be quite the experience as you peer into the crater that stretches down about three miles. Depending on the state of the volcano, you may see steam rising from the vents or an active lava lake. You will then head to the Volcano House, a historical hotel that Mark Twain visited in 1866 and mentioned in his book "Roughing It." There, you will be served Hawaiian fruit wine with traditional hors d'oeuvres known as pupus. The views from the hotel are spectacular as it perches about 4,000 feet above sea level and overlooks the Kilauea caldera.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Walk along the summit of Kilauea, one of the world's most active volcanoes.
- Enjoy Hawaiian fruit wine and traditional hors d'oeuvres at the historical Volcano House.
- Take in the panoramas of Volcanoes National Park from several vantage points.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

Need to Know:

Note: This tour includes a moderate amount of activity. It is available to guests who utilize a collapsible wheelchair, can both make their way on and off the coach, and have a companion to assist them. Those guests with mobility concerns are cautioned to evaluate their personal level of ability and stamina. The guided walk is not recommended for guests with mobility issues. Those with respiratory problems should be advised that there are sulfur fumes at certain areas within Volcanoes National Park. Guest must be of legal age to consume alcohol. Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the general

The Land Of Frozen Fire

Hilo, Hawaii

Pass through the visually stunning countryside in the Puna district just outside Hilo, where you will see lava fields from past eruptions and an extraordinary black-sand beach composed of lava fragments. According to legend, the volatile Hawaiian volcano goddess Pele lives in the district's Kīlauea volcano. She not only creates new land, but also destroys what stands in the path of the lava, which is known as "frozen fire" once it cools and hardens. However, the historical Painted Church was spared during Kīlauea's eruption in 1990 when the entire structure was lifted off its foundation and moved to safety. While browsing the wooden church, which features wonderful painted ceiling frescoes, you will hear more about its salvation. You will also visit a newly formed black-sand beach to learn intriguing details about the volcanic eruption that created it. Afterwards, you will have the opportunity to shop for locally made merchandise and meander along Hilo Bay.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Behold the devastation of past volcanic eruptions and the natural beauty left in their wakes.
- See the historical Painted Church that villagers moved to save it from a nearby lava flow.
- Gaze out over a gorgeous black-sand beach that a volcanic eruption created.
- Shop for locally made merchandise in and around Hilo.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear flat comfortable walking shoes.

Need to Know:

Note: All participants must be fully mobile and capable of walking at least 200 yards unaided on hills, lava and uneven terrain and be able to climb in and out of the van (scooters, wheelchairs, walkers cannot be accommodated). Participants must be at least 10 years of age. Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the general public.

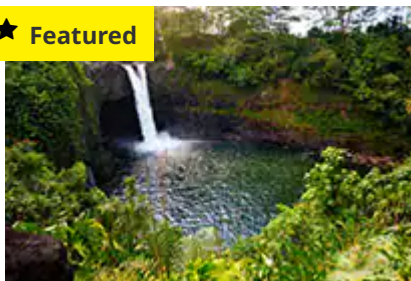
