Gold Coast & Cloud Forest

Kona, Hawaii

ACTIVITY LEVEL 3

Duration 3 1/2 hrs

Become immersed in the island's natural beauty by walking through a cloud forest that blankets the slopes of Hualalai volcano and along the sun-soaked Gold Coast. Low-level clouds usually waft through the forest, a botanical sanctuary of rare and endangered species. Expect to see giant fern trees, towering bamboo, and endemic ohia evergreens with fiery-red flowers. Another leisurely walk will present the charms of Kaoloko Honokohau National Historic Park, a protected coastal environment with the remains of an early Hawaiian settlement built on an ancient lava field. Highlights include temples, petroglyphs, and fishponds that attest to the ingenuity of the former residents. Hawaiian green sea turtles are commonly spotted along the shore, some weighing more than 300 pounds. The volcanic activity that shaped Hawaii left behind mineral-rich soil that is ideal for growing coffee as you will visit a local coffee plantation for a tour, and of course, a taste of their special brew.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Hike through the bio-diverse cloud forest that covers the dormant Hualalai volcano.
- Meander about an early Hawaiian coastal settlement built on a hardened lava field.
- Look for indigenous Hawaiian green sea turtles basking in the sun along the coast.
- Visit A local coffee plantation for a tour, and of course, a taste of their special brew..

Atlantis Submarine

Kona, Hawaii

Submerge yourself in a magnificent underwater world aboard an Atlantis Submarine. Investigate the reef through your personal viewport and come face-to-face with masses of exotic tropical fish and other marine creatures amidst colorful coral gardens.

Your adventure begins with a short boat ride along the scenic coast to the boarding dock, where you'll transfer to the submarine to begin your undersea adventure. Atlantis operates the world's most technologically advanced passenger submarines, with spacious air-conditioned interiors, large viewports and comfortable seating.

In crystal clear waters, you will descend 100 feet to explore 25 acres of coral gardens and their inhabitants. The reef was formed on lava that flowed into the ocean 18,000 years ago. Inhabited by hundreds of species of tropical fish, coral and other sea life, it's a popular site to see Hawaii's marine life.

The calm, year-round deep-sea fishing grounds off the Kona coast are teeming with marlin, ahi tuna, mahi-mahi, wahoo and short nose spearfish, to name just a few. Anglers from all over the globe have broken world records here.

Your tour includes transportation to and from Honokohau Harbor, a fully equipped sport-fishing boat that can accommodate up to six guests, and an experienced and licensed Captain and crew. Experience is not necessary, and even if you don't catch anything, you're sure to reel in some wonderful memories.

Explore Hawaii's underwater paradise without getting wet. Ride aboard the Marian, a 36-foot glass-bottom boat specially designed to cruise within inches of the reef. Throughout your adventure, an onboard narrator will share fun and interesting facts of the sea, historic points of interest, Hawaiian history, and other fascinating information about the area.

Have your camera ready to capture pictures of the stunning coral reef, colorful tropical fish, and fascinating marine life. Take in the breathtaking vistas of the island's rugged shoreline as the boat cruises along the historic Kona coast. Sometimes spinner dolphins or seasonal humpback whales (December to April) visit the bay near enough to view. The Marian is designed for comfort, with shaded seating as well as an open-air bow to catch some sun. The boat departs directly from the Kailua Pier, allowing you time to enjoy other excursions or a stroll through the village.

Your guided tour takes you for a visit to Pu'uhonua O Honaunau, which translates to "Place of Refuge at Honaunau." This enchanting cultural site is a lovingly restored ancient Hawaiian religious sanctuary. Built in 1650, the "Place of Refuge" originally housed the bones of Hawaiian chiefs. It later became a place of sanctuary for outlaws and defeated warriors. Highlights in this national historic park are the great Ki'i figures guarding the temple, the spectacular flora and fauna and the sense of peace and tranquility that echoes through the area.

A wide variety of Kona's famous coffees are on display at the Royal Kona Coffee Store. Refresh yourself with a sample and learn about the distinctive flavors in Kona's legendary brews. Coffee beans have been grown in the region since 1828. The nutrient-rich volcanic soil of Kona as well as the island's elevation and climate create ideal conditions for growing flavorful, quality coffee. You will have an opportunity to purchase some beans as a souvenir.

Continue through picturesque towns and villages, along magnificent coastal vistas and past historic landmarks and attractions. You'll return to port for the "sea" portion of your tour. Your guided historical lunch cruise on a 65' catamaran will capture your imagination and reveal secrets of the Big Island when ancient, powerful kings ruled the rugged and fertile land of the Hawaiian Islands. Unwind along the way and enjoy a deli-style lunch and beverages or enjoy your favorite libation from our full-service cash premium bar. Our Historian will share Hawaiian history, stories and legends relating to the numerous landmarks along 12 miles of Kona coastline. You'll visit famous points of interest including the Ahu'ena Heiau, Holua Slide and the Kaumo'o Battlefield. There's an excellent chance of seeing marine life during your cruise and

even humpback whales if you're with us during December-March. Enjoy live Hawaiian style music during the narration breaks and the entire trip back to the Kailua Pier.

Ultimate Cap'n Cook Snorkel & Coffee

Discover the Hawaii that British explorer Captain James Cook knew when he arrived in 1778, much of it in the shadow of Mauna Loa volcano. While touring the appropriately named Bay View Farm, which offers a beautiful view of Kealahou Bay, you will see how the farm grows, harvests, and roasts Kona coffee beans. A sampling will confirm why the coffee that flourishes in the rich volcanic soil is so revered. Nearby stands Pu'uuhonua, a spiritual site where criminals once sought refuge and absolution from Hawaiian priests. While browsing the grounds, you will see temple platforms and the remains of other structures that were intact in Captain Cook's time. A high-speed Zodiac-style raft will bring you to an obelisk marking the spot where Cook was killed following a dispute with the Hawaiians that lived on the bay. Feel free to swim and snorkel in the crystal-clear waters.

HIGHLIGHTS

- See areas of significance to Captain James Cook when he explored Hawaii in the late 1700s.
- Swim and snorkel in Kealahou Bay, where Cook anchored his ship while exploring.
- View the obelisk memorial that marks the spot on the bay where Cook was murdered.
- See how Kona coffee is grown and processed at a hillside plantation above the bay.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear comfortable walking shoes.

Experience rum tasting before you return back to your ship.

Once there you'll find snorkel gear and instruction for those who need it. But that's not all – there are also flotation toys, a 20-foot water slide, and a 15-foot high jump platform. Two extra wide swim platforms make it easy to get in and out of the water.

A continental breakfast, BBQ beef burger lunch, Hawaiian style chips, and white chocolate chip and freshly baked cookie for dessert and soft drinks are included.

Historic Kings Trail to North Kohala

Discover the lasting influence of King Kamehameha by exploring sites that were of great importance when he ruled Hawaii. Kamehameha is revered for uniting the Hawaiian Islands into one kingdom in 1810. About a decade earlier, the volcano Hualalai erupted, leaving hardened lava in its wake. While walking atop this rugged landscape, you will see petroglyphs and ingenious fishponds that the early Hawaiians created. Not far off, you will find a lava-rock temple built in the 18th century to fulfill a prophecy that Kamehameha would unite the islands. It is known as House of the Whale for the humpbacks often spotted just offshore. Following an alfresco lunch at a statue of Kamehameha that was erected near his birthplace in Kohala, you will be free to explore Hawi, an artistic community with all sorts of eclectic shops. You will also tour a macadamia factory and sample these iconic Hawaiian-grown nuts.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Follow in the footsteps of Kamehameha, the king that united the Hawaiian Islands.
- Walk across hardened lava from a volcano that erupted in Kamehameha's time.
- See petroglyphs, ancient fish ponds and an 18th-century temple built with lava rocks.
- Dine under a statue of Kamehameha near his birthplace in Kohala.
- Spend free time in the artistic community of Hawi and tour a macadamia nut factory.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Dress in weather-appropriate clothing.
- Wear long pants and closed-toe walking shoes.

Need to Know:

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. The trail is uneven but not too difficult. Walking sticks and binoculars included. Sun exposure of nearly 2 hours during the two outdoor exercise portion requires guests to stay hydrated and to have proper covering, sunscreen, and water. It is not recommended for guests who utilize a wheelchair. Those guests with mobility concerns are cautioned to evaluate their

personal level of ability and stamina.

Secret Waterfalls of Kohala

North Kohala is home to some of the most spectacular scenery in Hawaii – rushing streams, sparkling waterfalls, abundant tropical foliage and rugged sea cliffs. Immerse yourself in its deep green lushness and explore its rich natural and cultural heritage. A scenic drive to the remote north end of the island is accompanied by informative narration. Passing through a locked gate onto a private nature preserve, you'll then travel off-road for a short adventure to the trailhead.

An interpretive guide leads the way on the mile and a half trail. Along with an abundance of waterfalls, the route will take you across three bridges, along two idyllic streams, and past traditional Hawaiian taro terraces and irrigation flumes. Refresh yourself in a cool mountain stream with cascades tumbling overhead, or simply relax trailside. A picnic lunch is provided.

Behold the inspiring natural beauty of the Big Island and gain an appreciation for the volcanically shaped terrain. At Bay View Farm, which blankets the slopes of the Mauna Loa volcano, you will see how coffee beans are grown, dried, and roasted before tasting a cup of celebrated Kona coffee. The farm overlooks beautiful Kealahou Bay and the landmark statue that marks the spot where famed British explorer Captain James Cook was killed in 1779. Another look into the island's history awaits you at the 19th-century Painted Church, whose priest taught islanders religious lessons by painting biblical murals on the walls. Nature's glory really takes center stage in Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, where you will walk through a dramatic volcanic landscape that an 1868 eruption left in its wake. The lava that flowed into the ocean eventually created the black sand beach at Punalu'u, an idyllic setting where you may spot Hawaiian green sea turtles basking in the sun.

HIGHLIGHTS

- See how Kona coffee is grown and processed at a hillside plantation and sample a cup of it.
- View the biblical murals on the walls of the 19th-century Painted Church.
- Follow a nature trail through the gorgeous Hawaii Volcanoes National Park.
- Enjoy more natural beauty at the volcanically formed black sand beach at Punalu'u.

Zodiac Whale Watch

Zodiac Whale Watching is the best way to see the migrating humpback whales. Depart the tender pier to search out these gentle giants who come to Hawaii to mate and give birth. We are never sure where they are going to surface but the hurricane rafts are fast, getting you to the action quickly. We often see multiple whale pods on each trip. Naturalist guides will tell you about the humpback whale migration pattern and behavior and drop a hydrophone to listen to a whale song! Zodiac rafts accommodate small groups, so everyone gets a front row seat. Soft drinks and snacks are included.

This is a seasonal tour available from January – March.

Need to Know:

Note: The Zodiac ride can be a bit fast and you may get wet! Wear clothing you don't mind getting wet and bring cameras, but in some protective bag. There is an 18 inch step into the raft. This excursion is only available from January to the end of March.

Captain Zodiac Raft & Snorkel Adventure

Kona, Hawaii

Your adventure starts by viewing historical points of interest while off shore from the village of Kailua-Kona. While zipping down the coast on these fast and fun Zodiac Hurricanes, you may be able to stop to interact with marine life. There are 17 species of dolphins in Hawaii that may be seen on any given day. You may encounter the Hawaiian Spinner, Pacific Bottlenose or Spotted dolphins. As well as the seasonal Humpback whales that migrate yearly from Alaska (Jan-Apr), you may also find pilot whales, false killer whales and other rare, elusive whales that live here year-round. When you are in the Zodiac, you are just 2 feet above the water line, so you have a great vantage point from which to view the marine life.

Your ultimate destination is Kealakekua Bay marine preserve, site of the Captain Cook monument. Kealakekua Bay is known around the world for its abundance of coral and tropical fish - over 220 varieties of marine life in total. You will spend 1 ½ hours snorkeling the crystal-clear turquoise waters of the bay. All the snorkel gear is provided, including masks (RX if needed), snorkels, fins, and flotation devices. Non-swimmers and first-time snorkelers will be provided with flotation devices and instruction. There is a 3-4 rung ladder that is lowered from the Zodiac and you must be able to get up the ladder and back into the raft on your own. There is no access to land on this tour, the Zodiac is your "island" where you can get in and out of the water as often as you like at the snorkel spot.

While enjoying your tropical snacks and refreshments, you'll hear all about the history of the bay and the story of Captain Cook. You will get up close to explore the rugged coastline and see natural blowholes, exposed giant lava tubes and your Zodiac will poke its' nose into sea caves. See beautiful colors and striations of the lava up close. Your captain is a naturalist, geologist, historian and some like to think that they are comedians. It is guaranteed that you'll be laughing from the minute you step off the dock into the Zodiac.

Need to Know:

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and weigh no more than 320 lbs. Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel. This tour is not for guests who are pregnant, who have chronic back or neck

Boarding and disembarking the raft from the pier is a 2-foot step down onto the boat from the dock and then 2 more feet from the pontoon into the boat. At the snorkel site, a small 4 rung ladder is placed on the side of the raft and you will need to be able to climb to re-board the raft. Snorkelers must be able to swim. There is no shore landing. Due to new rules per the DLNR in order to protect our reef environment, only reef safe sunscreen will be allowed.

After touring this biodiverse farm, you will enjoy the best part--a chocolate tasting! In addition to coffee and cacao, learn how farm products are integrated into Kona Natural Soap which is also made here. Afterward, enjoy free time to browse their chocolate selections, Kona coffee and vegan soaps in the gift shop.

- Tour a cacao farm and watch each step of the cacao bean production.
- Sample a selection of coffees and chocolates that are pure Hawaiian..

Gain an understanding of the Big Island's history through attractions that highlight the life of the early Hawaiians and the influence of Catholic missionaries. Pu'uuhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park will offer a glimpse into the early culture, as it was a place of refuge for those that had violated the sacred laws known as kapu. There, you will see a temple where criminals could be absolved of their transgressions and safely return to society. To complement the experience, you will visit the 19th-century Painted Church. Its interior features frescoes and murals of biblical scenes that a Belgian priest painted to teach the islanders Catholicism. The missionaries were also instrumental in dismantling the harsh kapu laws. You will also learn how coffee was introduced to Hawaii in the 1820s and how it is processed today at the Royal Kona Coffee Center. It is an excellent setting to enjoy a cup of fresh-brewed Kona coffee.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit one Hawaii's most sacred sites, where criminals could find safe refuge.
- View the biblical murals and frescoes that adorn the Painted Church.
- Enjoy a cup of Kona coffee and learn about its production at a coffee mill.
