Wednesday 29 January 2025**COZ67 - SAVE A TURTLE!**

Every year from spring to autumn, the shores of Cozumel turn into a breeding ground for loggerhead and green sea turtles, two endangered species that this tour gives you a chance to help save. After the female turtle has laid her eggs in a hole she digs in the sand using her hind flippers, they will hatch about 100 to 150 days later under cover of the night. The little hatchlings then embark on the most dangerous journey of their young lives - the mad scramble over the sand to reach the relative safety of the sea. While this entirely natural process enjoys a high success rate, some 20% of the baby turtles lack the strength or stamina to climb out of their nesting hole. This is where you come in and, instructed by a qualified marine biologist, stand to make a real difference to the previous evening's hatchlings, little lives that would otherwise not survive. Your task involves first digging the young turtles out of their nests and then taking them to Cozumel's Marine Biology Outpost where they will be looked after until their internal organs have matured sufficiently for them to be released into the sea. Don't miss this truly heart-warming experience and make your contribution to wildlife preservation in the most hands-on way possible. The tour draws to a close with your return to the ship. Please note: guests are advised that digging out the turtle hatchlings may involve working on your knees or lying down on the sand. To avoid injuring any baby turtles, the digging process is entirely by hand (no shovels, trowels or other tools may be used). Although female turtles usually dig their nests relatively close to the water, some places may be easier to dig in than others. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable clothes, a hat, high-factor sunscreen and comfortable shoes for walking on the beach. This tour is available only during the Summer calls to Cozumel, Mexico starting from August through October. Guests will be required to sign a waiver which may only be available in English.

You will be surprised while they perform acrobatic leaps and behaviours for you, showing how fast they swim in nature. Enjoy a private VIP lounge and Terrace area and indulge yourself with culinary delights and premium drinks and get ready to discover the archaeological sites, Tequila Village, Swimming pool, crocodile exhibition and just simply relax at the sandy beach. Bring your snorkel gear or rent on-site to come face to face with a variety of colourful tropical fish in this sanctuary of natural beauty and diversity. Please note: Minimum height is 48 inches. Children must be over 12 years old to participate on their own. A parent or guardian must be present as an observer (please ask for availability). Situated just off Mexico's south-eastern coast, the island of Cozumel presents a winning blend of culture, history, scenery, fabulous beaches and great shopping opportunities. In short, it has the lot - and you can explore some of its most attractive features on this half-day tour. Your outing begins with an air-conditioned coach ride to your first stop: the Discover Mexico Park, a complex that represents some of Mexico's most iconic landmarks in perfect scale models. After visiting the park's museum, complete with a special video experience room. Continue your journey to a unique place for a sensory experience at The Mayan Cacao Company where you will learn about the history of the Chocolate, its manufacturing process and you'll also participate in a demonstration with a delicious tasting at the end. With views of untamed beaches to enjoy as you round the island's southern tip, you'll then head for your third destination, the natural limestone bridge of El Mirador. View, photograph and even walk over the unusual rock, before moving to a wonderful "Tequileria" to see how tequila, Mexico's national drink, is made. Your final stop is Cozumel's downtown - shopping district where you'll have time to explore on your own. You will be free to decide whether to return to the ship using the transport provided at the appointed time or remain in town for longer and return at your own expense. Please note: The tour is unsuitable for guests with mobility problems or using a wheelchair. We recommend bringing high-factor sunscreen, a hat, sunglasses and some cash to cover the cost of any additional purchases as well as wearing comfortable walking shoes and light clothing.

You will set off on your kayak tour at the Uvas Beach Club and paddle through the crystal-clear waters of the Caribbean, all the while being able to observe the wildlife below thanks the kayak's transparent keel. An amazing underwater world of colourful tropical fish and fascinating coral reef formations will unfold right before your eyes. The next leg of the tour will then give you an opportunity to put on your snorkelling gear and take a closer look at the fascinating world and its many colourful inhabitants under the sea. All that activity can only mean one thing: time for a rest. On returning to the gorgeous beach and its facilities, you can simply relax and work on your tan, go for a swim or cool off under a shady umbrella. A drink and a selection of fresh fruit will be served free of charge, but those with a bigger appetite could order food from the restaurant at additional cost. In the end, you can choose either to return to the ship when the transportation departs, or stay on for longer and use taxi vouchers (issued on request) for your return trip a little later. Please note: the tour is not suitable for pregnant women, guests using a wheelchair or with pre-existing heart, respiratory, back/neck problems. CULTURE AND HISTORY

Experience Xcaret - the most exciting and largest Eco Park in Latin America! This eco-archaeological park offers many exhilarating activities in a tropical jungle setting on the Caribbean Sea. It is pure fun and enjoyment in a natural setting. As you get off the ferry in Playa Del Carmen, your guide will take you to your transportation for a short ride to Xcaret. At the park, your guide will assist you on where to go, what there is to do, answer your questions and point you in the right direction. Then, you are on your own to explore and experience the park. Choose from the museum, a bird sanctuary, stables, botanical gardens, aquarium, restored Mayan ruins, a replicated Mayan village, beautiful beaches and natural pools. Even take a swim in an underground river with life vest included. Please note: transfer by ferry to Playa del Carmen lasts approximately 45 minutes and could possibly be rough depending on the sea conditions. The price of the tour includes use of a life vest for swimming in the river; if required, snorkel equipment can be hired at additional expense. Optional activities are available at additional costs. Start your "Once in a life time experience" in the most beautiful dolphinarium in the World! Located in the heart of Cozumel's shopping area, it is the only place in all the Caribbean where you can swim with dolphins in the safety of still ocean coves. Experience the excitement of riding on a dolphin belly in our unique "Dolphin Swim & Ride" program. Dig in to unlimited food and drinks, snorkel with tropical fish in our natural aquarium, and venture onto the ocean for kayaking and paddle boarding, all at no additional cost. Your adventure begins with a short taxi ride to Dolphinaris. Before entering the water you will enjoy a Dolphin behavioural presentation where you will be introduced to some of the extraordinary dolphins' behaviour. The first part of the program is conducted on a waist deep water submerged platform. You will then proceed into the deeper water of our natural ocean coves to swim and touch the dolphin in its own environment where then, you will come face to face with a dolphin as you grasp the dolphin's fins and the dolphin pulls you across the surface of the water on a Belly Ride. You will also have the opportunity to get a kiss, pectoral fin shake and caress the dolphins. CULTURE AND HISTORY



Come experience the world famous, magnificent ruins of the walled city of Tulum the only Mayan city built right on the crystal blue Caribbean Sea! After a short ferry ride to Playa Del Carmen, your guide will take you to an air-conditioned motor coach for a scenic and informative drive to Tulum. Once there, your guide will escort you through the ruins giving a complete narration along the way. See restored temples and some of the mysterious hieroglyphic writings still visible today. Visit the temple of the frescos famous for the detailed carved figures and original paints. And, perched on the edge of the Caribbean and rising high above all of the other ruins is "el Castillo" with its breathtaking view of the blue water below. A light box lunch is included. Guests will have the option to continue the exploration of the ruins or take a swim at the beach. Please note: Transfer by ferry to Playa del Carmen lasts approximately 45 minutes and could possibly be rough depending on the sea conditions. Transfer by bus to Tulum is approximately 1 hour each way. Optional transfer by tram to the ruins from the parking lot at Tulum is at guests' expense and risk. There is a government tax of US\$5-8 on the use of video cameras in the ruins. No tripods and/or professional video cameras are allowed. Tour is not recommended for guests with mobility problems or wheelchair bound. A small beach is located at Tulum. Guests must be able to ascend and descend stairs to enter and exit the water. The swimming at the beach is optional and will depend of the sea weather conditions. Swim at your own risk. No lifeguard is available. The time at the beach is limited during guests' free time. Guests will meet the guide on arrival in Playa del Carmen. To avoid damaging the fragile ruins, climbing them is prohibited.

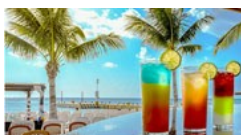

Enjoy a comfortable air-conditioned bus ride transportation to and from Playa Mia®, unlimited national open bar, exquisite self-service international buffet and over 20 attractions and services will be available. You will have access to the underwater Mayan city and to the shopping center and to facilities such as beach umbrella, swimming pool, lounge chairs, volleyball & soccer court, bungee trampoline, ping-pong tables, kids club & playground, kayaks, paddle boats, sailboats, water trampoline, water bicycles and floating mats. Let loose in the amazing new Water Park. Explore Buccaneer's Bay Kids Area; a lagoon pool full of fun activities such as water-canons, pirate ship, water sprays & animal slides; relax with your favourite cocktail at the Oasis Island Pool & make a splash on the 200- foot long twin twister waterslide. Please note: the venue is wheelchair accessible and is equipped with beach wheelchairs; they are available on a first-come-first-served basis. Guests using a wheelchair are advised that they must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach and that wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Guests using a wheelchair who would like to participate in this tour are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made at least 48 hours prior. All children 12 years of age and younger or non-swimmers must be accompanied and supervised one-on-one by a parent or legal guardian. Any visitor having a skin disease, lesions or infections, open sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, communicable disease, even a mild case of diarrhea or who has any considerable area of exposed sub-skin tissues, open blisters, cuts, or/and is wearing any kind of bandage or band-aid are not permitted in the pool. The Water Park and attractions are available in the modality of first-come-first-serve basis. The kids using the Buccaneer's Bay Water Toys must have a Maximum Height of 1.20m or 3 feet 11 inches of height. In addition, kids may have a Maximum weight of 60 kg, 132 pounds. Shoes of any kind not allowed. Guests must have a minimum height of 1 m or 3 feet 3 inches to participate in the Twin Twister Waterslide. Guest's maximum weight is 114 kg. or 251 pounds to participate in the slides. Beginning with a transfer to mainland Mexico and then onwards to reach the archaeological site, this all-day excursion seeks to familiarise you with the ancient Mayan city of Chichen Itza. Once a powerful metropolis from c. A.D. 600 to 1200, the generously proportioned site features hundreds of incredible structures that placed it among the Seven New Wonders of the World. Your guided walk around the site will also include a visit to the impressive pyramid of Kulkulkan (also known as El Castillo), the meticulously preserved Mayan ball court, the evocatively named cenote of sacrifices and the warriors' temple. But you'll also get to see the observatory, the place where Mayan priests would assemble to precisely predict the constellation of the stars over a time span of a million years. If one takes stock of how Europeans lived during the same time period, the astronomical and engineering feats of these ancient Mayans just seem all the more exceptional.
